

## **Romanby Golf and Country Club Terms of Competitions As at 01 November 2025**

**These Terms of Competitions are to be read in conjunction with the Competition Rules published on the Romanby Golf and Country Club website.**

### **Handicap Index**

Players in club competitions must hold a current, active handicap index. The Club Competition Committee can apply a handicap limit for competitions, and these will be shown on the entry forms. Players with a greater handicap index may play but off the Playing Handicap limit permitted. Other restrictions may also be applied, see the notice board for information on the entry forms.

### **Methods of Entry**

On the day of Competition, *competitors must sign in and pay the appropriate fee in the Professional Shop before commencing play.* Initial competition sign up is conducted through the Competition "Sign Up" function available through BRS.

### **Caddies**

Caddies are expressly forbidden in all adult Competitions, including knockout competitions. Players with registered disabilities are entitled to caddies under Rule 25. In all other cases, members using a caddie will be deemed to be in breach of Rule 10.3a.

### **Minimum number of entrants**

For competitions to be deemed "valid", all Competitions shall have a minimum of 5 entrants with the exception of Ladies (4 entrants) and Juniors Competitions which shall have a minimum of 2 entrants.

### **Maximum Handicaps**

Sections may set restrictions and/or limits on the handicaps eligible for entry or use in a competition. For an eclectic/ multi-round competition played over one day or consecutive days, members will play the entire competition with the handicap as of the first round, or if the player will use their revised handicap for each round.

### **Bad Weather Policy**

In the event that the course becomes unplayable and is closed by the Course Management, or the Competition Committee decides that the course is not in a good enough condition to play a drawn/ qualifier/trophy competition, then the competition shall be cancelled and rearranged at the earliest possible date. If, however, competitors choose either not to play, or to discontinue play, because of the bad weather and the course remains open the competition shall be deemed to have been played and will not be rescheduled. In such cases competitors who do not complete their round will receive a score of Nett Double Bogey not played/ completed and disqualified under Rule 3.3.

### **Scores**

Competition scores are to be inputted to the 'Handicap Master' competition scoring system on the club computer. Results of Knockout Matches are to be passed to the relevant Competition Secretary to be finalised and not input directly onto Handicap Master by the competitors.

### **Ties**

Except where otherwise provided in the conditions of a particular event, all ties shall be decided on the back 9, 6, 3, or 1 hole. If a tie remains, it shall be decided by the front 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes. If a tie remains the Competition Committee shall decide the method of producing a result, this decision shall be final.

### **Eligibility**

Only current, amateur, members of Romanby Golf and Country Club with an active Handicap Index are eligible to play in competitions unless otherwise stated.

Junior Competitions may only be entered by current members of the Romanby Golf and Country Club Junior section aged 18 years or younger on the day of the competition.

Senior competitions may only be entered by current members of the Romanby Golf and Country Club aged 55 years or older on the day of the competition.

Rabbits competitions may only be entered by current members of the Romanby Golf and Country Club with a Handicap Index between 15.0 and 54.0 on the first day of the competition.

Ladies competitions may only be entered by current female members of Romanby Golf and Country Club on the day of the competition.

### **Withdrawals**

Players must notify the respective Competition Secretary as soon as possible of any withdrawal. Any changes to the draw must be made through the relevant Competition Secretary and not through the Club/ Pro and no later than 48 hrs prior to the Competition. Members withdrawing less than 48 hrs prior to a Competition will be required to pay their Entry Fees unless there are extenuating circumstances. The Committee will have the discretion to waive the entry fee in exceptional circumstances. A player MUST not, without consent of the Committee, remove their name from the BRS booking system for a competition.

### **Time of Starting**

Time of Starting (Rule 5-3a). All players in a group must be present and ready to play at the time established by the Committee and must be present on the 1st tee at least five minutes before their start time. A player teeing off earlier, or more than 5 minutes later, than the time allotted will be disqualified. Teeing off 5 minutes late or early would give them the General Penalty. Start times will be displayed on the club notice board and on the BRS golf booking system.

### **Prizes**

No more than 80% of the entry fee will be allocated to prizes. Prizes may be of monetary value, items bought from the entry fee or provided by a sponsor, or vouchers. No cash will be awarded as a prize; money will be put on individual accounts in the Professional shop. 20% of ALL entry fees will be returned to Romanby Golf Club.

### **Winners**

Competition winners will be announced by publishing electronically on Master Scoreboard or placing the results on the club notice board.

### **Local Rules**

Local Rules apply to all competitions and are shown on the club scorecard and club noticeboards.

### **Return of Scores**

All scores are to be entered on the Club Competition Computer in the Clubhouse using the Handicap Master software unless stated otherwise above. Cards must be clearly legible and completed in accordance with Rule 3.3 of the Rules of Golf.

Once entered on the Competition Computer, completed cards are to be placed in the wooden box on the table to the right of the computer cabinet or in the box in the Ladies' locker room.

Scorecards are considered to have been returned once they have been entered in the computer, cards left in the box and the player has left the Club property. Failure to return a card in this manner may result in the Player's disqualification under Rule 3.3.

### **Publication of Results**

Results are finalised once the competition has been "closed" on Handicap Master and the results published through the Handicap Master software and or placed on the Main/ Section noticeboards.

**Handicap Calculation**

All playing handicaps are calculated using the corresponding (100%, 95% etc) England Golf Handicap chart as displayed in the Pro Shop.

Shots for each player in the Knockout Competitions are calculated from the player with the Lowest Handicap.
